
to operate a composting plant on the premises to treat Category 3 animal by-products, including catering waste in accordance with the Annex.

2. Samples of the treated product shall be taken from either 25% of the batches (one tunnel load being a batch) or once a month, once material has been taken out of the tunnel (vessel) after having achieved at least + 60 degree Celsius for a minimum of 48 hours throughout and tested for *Salmonella* and *E.coli* (or *Enterococaceae*).
