1. In accordance with Regulation 14 of The Animal By-Products (Enforcement) (England) Regulations 2013/The Animal By-Products (Enforcement) (Wales) Regulations 2014, and Articles 24 and 44 of Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009, the Secretary of State/Welsh Ministers approves:

to operate a composting plant on the premises to treat Category 3 animal by-products, including catering waste in accordance with the Annex.

2. Samples of the treated product shall be taken from either 25% of the batches (one tunnel load being a batch) or once a month, once material has been taken out of the tunnel (vessel) after having achieved at least + 60 degree Celsius for a minimum of 48 hours throughout and tested for Salmonella and E.coli (or Enterococaceae).
